

Encounter Winter Camp Rules



Encounter is simple, so are the rules, below are the rules for every person and group while at camp.

1. Respect the People: Monadnock is a safe place where everyone will honor and respect one another.

2. Respect the Place: The buildings, grounds, facilities and infrastructure of Monadnock are old, and while we are constantly updating, repairing, replacing and maintaining; we need your help in preserving what God has given us. Please do not disrespect these grounds and facilities by destroying them. Your group will be held financially accountable if any malicious damage is caused by your group.

3. Be at the Right Place at the Right Time: One of the unique aspects of Encounter is the opportunity for your group to participate (or not participate) in any of the activities. However, we ask that every group be at the following camp-wide activities:

A. Meal Times (tables and meal shifts are assigned by group)

B. Chapel Sessions (seating is assigned, and is advertised on the screen 15 minutes before each session)

C. Game Finale (seating is assigned, and is advertised on the screen 15 minutes prior to the Game Finale)

D. Group Discussion Time (there is time intentionally set aside after each session for group discussion time. Your group will be given a room or space in which to discuss and debrief each message. Speakers will have discussion questions available if you would like to use them.)

4. No “Making Purple”: Monadnock enjoys running a coed camp. It can promote what it means to have healthy relationships and boundaries. Therefore, we ask all students not to make purple. Every student and leader should stay in lit areas and not be in the dorm(s) of the opposite sex.

***Youth leaders are responsible for their students. Camp leadership will approach youth leaders if an issue arises.**
